AN IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM OUR WOMENS HEALTH LEADS DR SHARMA & SISTER GRAINGER RE CERVICAL SCREENING

Please remember that prevention is better than cure. We've noticed that less women are booking in for their cervical smear tests and this is a cause for concern. Women aged 25-60 are eligible for a cervical smear test every 3-5 years to detect the HPV virus or cell changes **<u>BEFORE</u>** cancer develops.

So as you look towards the New Year, please ensure you book in for your smear test when you are due. <u>To Families</u>- please encourage the women in your life to look after themselves & get booked in. <u>Cervical screening - NHS (www.nhs.uk)</u>

AND NOT FORGETTING THE CHAPS.....

In 2023, HHP along with Fleet PCN, was involved in the Medefer Prostate Screening Project. We are proud to be part of helping the UK to develop a

reliable prostate cancer screening programme in the future. To date, we have screened 934 pre-identified men who had no symptoms of prostate cancer. Of these, 26 were referred urgently to Urology under the 2 week rule suspected cancer pathway. Of these, 5 have been diagnosed with prostate cancer that would otherwise have gone undiagnosed due to lack of symptoms. We continue to service this project and await further data regarding the success and longevity of this research.
